

### Particular conditions of the Grand Prix of Europe 2010

- No refunds or exchanges are available in respect of tickets unless the event is cancelled.
- The promoter is not responsible for tickets not purchased direct from the promoter or through an official ticket agency. Damaged or with any evidence of forgery tickets will become void and the holder may be refused entry to or ejected from the venue.
- The promoter reserves the right to alter the seat allocations without prior notice, if there were a justifiable cause.
- The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission and to remove persons from the venue, in the terms and conditions provided by law.
- For your security whilst at the venue, the promoter uses CCTV cameras. You consent to any footage that may be taken of you for general security measures. Any kind of use of the recorded images will be in accordance with the provisions and circumstances provided under the Private Data Protection law and current legislation, and may be referred to respective authorities if required.
- The promoter has the right to search any person entering the venue in the terms and conditions provided by law. The following articles must not be brought within the venue: alcoholic drinks, weapons, articles that might be used as a weapon, or compromise public safety or might be considered dangerous by the promoter or forbidden by current law. Any person in possession of such items or under the influence of alcohol, narcotics, psychotropics, stimulants or similar substances will be refused entry to the venue.
- No animals will be admitted to the venue, except for guide dogs in the terms and conditions provided by R.D. 3250/1983-3250/1983.
- You must not make, create, store, record or transmit any kind of sound recording, visual footage, audiovisual recording, or store, record or transmit any information or other data, including official timing, results, performance, telemetry, weather or race control data of, at or in relation to the event. It is forbidden to take into the venue any equipment that may enable you to do the aforementioned acts. Personal electronic devices (including still image cameras, mobile telephones and other personal handheld communications devices) are permitted within the venue unless otherwise advised, provided that any Recording, Data and any image, including photographic images and any still pictures derived or capable of being derived from a Recording of the event that is recorded, stored and/or created thereon is used for personal, private and non-commercial purposes only. As a condition of entry you agree (i) that any Recording, Data or Image shall not be used for any form of public advertisement, display, commercial gain or for any other purpose, except for your personal and private enjoyment, without the prior written consent of Formula One Administration (FOA) and (ii) on request by promoter or FOA you shall assign to FOA in writing the copyright and all other intellectual property in any Image or Recording you create, make, store or record of at or in relation to the event.
- Motor racing is dangerous and noisy. Sanctioning bodies, FOA, Formula One Management Limited, FIA, Allsport Management S.A., APM Sport (Ireland) Limited, Allsopp Parket and Marsh (Ireland) Limited, organizers of the event (including officials, marshals, rescue, medical staff), competitors and drivers, are not responsible for any loss or damage, howsoever caused, to you to the maximum extent permitted by law (except in the case of death of personal injury caused by negligence of the above parties).
- No goods on any nature may be offered either free or for sale by any not authorized person within the venue.
- Save for official merchandise you shall not bring into, use or display within the venue any sponsorship, promotional or marketing materials.
- The promoter reserves the right to request you to leave the venue at any time for safety reasons.
- During the event the noise level may be very loud within the venue. You are advised to wear hearing protection to reduce the risk of hearing damage.
- While at the venue you must always keep to the designated paths and maintain safe, prudent and respectful behaviour and comply with all security measures and instructions given to you by organization staff.
- You must keep your ticket safe and in good condition as a duplicate ticket will not be issued if it is lost or stolen, and a defaced or illegible ticket may become invalid.
